



Do as Much or as Little as you Like, when staying at Tideline Palm Beach Ocean Resort and Spa

Palm Beach, FL- (May 13, 2024) [The Tideline Palm Beach Ocean Resort and Spa](#) is a haven of its own, located directly on the best beachfront in Palm Beach County. Take a stroll along the waterfront, try paddleboarding or surfing, or visit the nearby Municipal Pier, located just a short beach walk from the resort.

There is a plethora of sun, fun and activities close to the resort, ideal for singles, couples and families alike. The [John Prince Memorial Park](#) is a great place to start, and offers biking, fishing, canoeing, the Lake Woof Dog Park and even a golf learning center.

If it is culture that you are looking for, visit the Henry Morrison Flagler Museum, on Palm Beach Island. Swing into the Gilded Age, with a tour of his magnificent estate, Whitehall. This National Historic Landmark has been restored to its original glamour of 1902. The museum offers changing exhibitions and one can even visit Flagler's private railcar #91, which dates to 1896.

A trip to Palm Beach is not complete without a stop on the famous, star-studded Worth Avenue, home to some of the world's most exclusive brands and boutiques. Whether you are window-shopping or buying, you will enjoy stores such as Cartier, Gucci and Louis Vuitton as well as specialty stores such as La Costiera, a specialty Italian sandal store where your custom-made sandals will be completed in 24 hours. Another must see is the Lilly Pulitzer boutique, known for comfortable resort wear in the iconic bright floral patterns. And stop at Pizza Al Fresco, where one can find the only cemetery in Palm Beach, an actual pet cemetery. Here lies the grave of the infamous spider monkey Johnnie Brown, who belonged to architect Addison Mizner*.

If golf is your game, try a round or two at the nearby [Palm Beach Par 3 Golf Course](#).

This course was originally designed by the great golf course architect Dick Wilson and his apprentice Joe Lee in 1961, and was then renovated in 2009 by legendary PGA Tour champion Raymond Floyd. The 18-hole, paspalum turf course also offers a Clubhouse, complete with a Pro Shop and al fresco Restaurant and Bar.

And for baseball fans, a trip to Tideline is not complete without a stop at the CACTI Park of the Palm Beaches during Spring Training 2. Here one can watch Spring Training up close and personal with the 2022 World Series Champion Houston Astros and the 2019 World Series Champion Washington Nationals.
